The concept focuses on a positive aspect related with solidarity, respect, equality and giving. We want to concentrate on "good" things locals can offer to refugee children, rather than cause guilt to the audience by describing once again the harsh conditions they are obliged to live in. Donating is a positive action and needs to be motivated through a positive campaign.

Immigrants Education is primarily about teaching them the local language, for them to **be able to communicate** with society for their everyday needs, but also to **help them be integrated**.




Background and typeface are suggestive

The light blue gradients convey a sunny morning feeling, synonymous to hope.


